1. The person in charge of the testing by request is responsible for all operations concerning the requested testing. If the person in charge changes, please notify the testing laboratory in writing immediately.
2. Delivery of testing and improved products shall be made to one of the laboratories listed below. The applicant is responsible for delivery of products.

3. Estimated testing fees must be paid in advance as a prepayment of the testing and other expenses.
4. In the event that damage or defect to the test product is found, the laboratory shall notify the applicant, and the applicant shall immediately take appropriate measures.
5. If the test results indicate that the product does not conform to the applicable testing standards, the testing laboratory shall notify the applicant of non-conformity. If the prepayment was inadequate, the applicant must pay the remainder of the fee.
6. If a defect in the test product is found during testing and there is little prospect that the product will meet the testing standards, the testing laboratory shall issue to the applicant a notice of non-conformity or a notice of required improvements indicating that information and recommending that the applicant withdraws the product from the requested testing.
7. The testing laboratory shall return the product in its post-testing condition. The laboratory is not responsible for any dismantling or damage that occurs during testing.
8. The applicant shall select one of the following post-testing dispositions of the product.

(1) Return the product postage collect.

(2) Product to be retrieved by the applicant.

(3) Product to be discarded.

If the product is to be retrieved, it must be retrieved within 60 days of issuance of the test report. If the product is not retrieved within this period, the laboratory may discard the product. In such case, the applicant shall bear all expenses for retrieval or disposal of the post-testing product.

9. If an agent is appointed for this purpose, a Power of Attorney shall be submitted and all powers and responsibilities shall be granted to the agent.
