Application Methods for S-JET Certification under the revision of the Description of Electrical Appliances and Materials, Appendix 10 (Radio Noise)

Technical requirements the ministerial ordinance for electrical appliance Appendix 10 (Radio Noise) have been consolidated to the harmonized standards of Appendix 12 (J55014-1(H27), J55032(H29), etc.) in compliance with the international standards.

The grace period is set to Aug. 30th, 2028.

Please find the application methods on the S-JET Certification at JET as follows:

SUBJECTS:

The applicants who plan to apply for S-JET Certification based on Appendix 8 and the applicants under planning to apply

1. Application

(1) Application for Conformity Assessments under the Revised Appendix 10 (J55014-1(H27), J55032(H29), etc.), i.e., (The new description)

In case of the application under the new description, please fulfill '5. Applied Standard for Testing' of 'APPLICATION FORM (Form 1-1/2)' as "Appendix 8 and Appendix 10 Jxx(Hxx)" (to 'xx', please enter the standard number and year of Appendix 12 which is applied to the electrical appliance).

(2) Application under the Former Description Appendix 10 (Article 1 - 9), i.e., (The former description): Application to Standard Revision Assessment test

Certification based on the applied standard for testing under the former description requires completion of standard revision by Aug. 30th, 2028 (end of the grace period) *.

* Please note some products have shorter grace periods by Jul. 31st, 2026.

If the standard revision assessment is not completed by the end of the grace period, the shipping of the product having S-JET marking will be prohibited. Just before Aug. 30th, 2028 (end of the grace period), quite higher volume of applications for Standard Revision Assessment is anticipated. An application at your earliest convenience, therefore, is

highly recommended.

(3) Application for Conformity Assessments under the Former Description

Application under the former description will be acceptable by the end of the grace period. In this case, please fulfill '5. Applied Standard for Testing' of 'APPLICATION FORM (Form 1-1/2)' as "Appendix 8 and Appendix 10 (Article xx)" (to 'xx', please enter the article number which is applied to the electrical appliance). Please note that completion of the standard revision by the end of the grace period is essential.

2. Entry of the Applied Standard for Testing on the Certificate

(1) Sample Entry according to The New Description

Application under the new description requires the following entries.

Sample (Electric kettles): Appendix 8 Section 1, Section 2 Chapter 9 and Appendix 10 J55014-1(H27)

Sample (Electromagnetic cookers): Appendix 8 Section 1, Section 2 Chapter 8-2 and Appendix 10 J55011(H27)

(2) Sample Entry according to The Former Description

Application under the former description requires no changes from the former case.

Sample (Electric kettles): Appendix 8 Section 1, Section 2 Chapter 9 and Appendix 10 Chapter 5

3. Supplements
